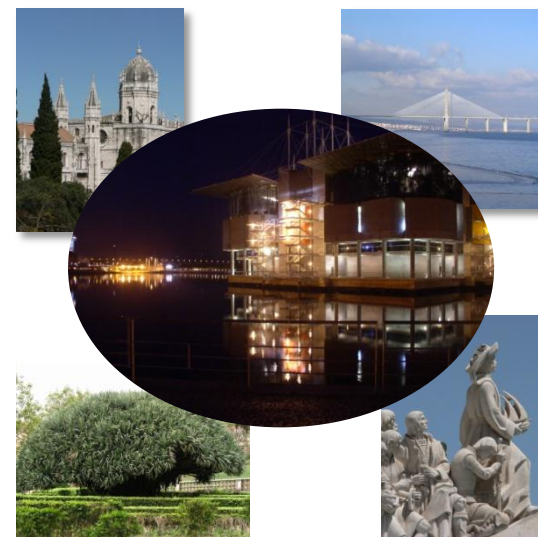

Abstract submission

Short lectures and posters related to the above mentioned topics are welcome. All participants should submit a condensed version of their contribution, not larger than a page 8.5 x 11 inches, formatted in Arial font (size 11, 1.5 spacing). Margins should not exceed 2.5 cm in all directions. Everyone interested in contributing with an abstract is kindly requested to proceed to submission before June 1st, 2010. All abstracts will be reviewed by the scientific Committee and relevant notifications about acceptance or rejection will be sent out to the presenting author by July 1st, 2010. The names of the referees will not be disclosed, except at the end of the conference and by mutual agreement of the interested scientists and scholars.
